



DIRECTOR'S ORDER NUMBER ONE HUNDRED TEN (2025)

CERTAIN VIRGINIA LOTTERY COMPUTER GENERATED GAME; CHANGE TO PRIZE PAYMENT

This Order is issued in accordance with §§ 2.2-4002B (15) and 58.1-4006A of the Code of Virginia. Notice is hereby given that the Virginia Lottery Game **MEGA MILLIONS (49 2025)** is amended as follows:

in Section N. PRIZE PAYMENT

From:

6. Virginia Lottery law prohibits the disclosure of information about an individual Prizewinner's identity for a Prize greater than \$10 million, unless that Prizewinner consents in writing to such disclosure.
7. For Prizes up to and including \$10 million, a Prizewinner agrees to participate in a press conference, and agrees to the use of the Prizewinner's name and/or photo for publicity, at the Lottery's discretion. Examples of publicity include, but are not limited to, news releases, Internet, news media and signs at Lottery Retailer locations. In addition, a Prizewinner agrees to participate in Lottery promotional efforts, which may include the Prizewinner's name, hometown, the amount of the Prize won, and the Game won, through "social media," which may include, but will not be limited to, YouTube®, X (formerly Twitter®), Facebook®, Instagram®, or similar efforts, without additional consent from or compensation to the Prizewinner.

To:

6. Virginia Lottery law prohibits the disclosure of information about an individual Prizewinner's identity for a Prize of \$1 million or greater, unless that Prizewinner consents in writing to such disclosure.
7. For Prizes under \$1 million, a Prizewinner agrees to participate in a press conference and agrees to the use of the Prizewinner's name and/or photo for publicity at the Lottery's discretion. Examples of publicity include, but are not limited to, news releases, Internet, news media and signs at Lottery retailer locations. In addition, a Prizewinner agrees to participate in Lottery promotional efforts, which may include the Prizewinner's name, hometown, the amount of the Prize won, and the game won, through "social media," which may include, but will not be limited to, YouTube®, X (formerly Twitter®), Facebook®, Instagram® or similar efforts, without additional consent from or compensation to the Prizewinner.



With the exception of the foregoing changes, all terms, conditions, and requirements of the original order and the original game rules continue to apply and remain in full force and effect.
