

SELLING BONUS PROGRAM



If your store sells a winning draw-game ticket or Scratcher and the prize is \$20,000 or more, you'll earn a selling bonus. A breakdown of the bonus levels is in the chart at right.

A Virginia Lottery retailer will earn a selling bonus if:

- A draw-game ticket sold by the retailer is determined to be a winning ticket according to the rules and regulations of the Virginia Lottery.
- A Scratcher sold by the retailer is claimed by a player and validated by Virginia Lottery officials according to the rules and regulations of the Virginia Lottery.

Payment for a selling bonus will be credited to a retailer's Virginia Lottery account and will appear on the retailer's Virginia Lottery statement.

SELLING BONUS LEVELS

| PRIZE VALUE | BONUS |
|-------------------------------|-----------|
| \$20,000–\$49,999.99 | \$250 |
| \$50,000–\$99,999.99 | \$500 |
| \$100,000–\$499,999.99 | \$750 |
| \$500,000–\$4,999,999.99* | \$10,000 |
| \$5,000,000–\$499,999,999.99* | \$50,000 |
| \$500,000,000 or more* | \$100,000 |

*If a retailer sells a winning draw-game ticket or Scratcher and the prize will be given as an annuity, the selling bonus will be calculated based on the cash value of the prize.
