## BONUS PROGRAM

If your store sells a winning draw-game ticket or
Scratcher and the prize is $\mathbf{\$ 2 0 , 0 0 0}$ or more, you'll earn a selling bonus. A breakdown of the bonus levels is in the chart at right.

A Virginia Lottery retailer will earn a selling bonus if:

- A draw-game ticket sold by the retailer is determined to be a winning ticket according to the rules and regulations of the Virginia Lottery.
- A Scratcher sold by the retailer is claimed by a player and validated by Virginia Lottery officials according to the rules and regulations of the Virginia Lottery.

Payment for a selling bonus will be credited to a retailer's Virginia Lottery account and will appear on the retailer's Virginia Lottery statement.

*If a retailer sells a winning draw-game ticket or Scratcher and the prize will be given as an annuity, the selling bonus will be calculated based on the cash value of the prize.
