Principal and Surety shall jointly and severally be liable to the Obligee for the amount of the Proposal Guarantee.

The Surety represents to the Principal and the Obligee that it is legally authorized to provide these services in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

This Protest Bond shall be governed in all respects by the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and any litigation with respect hereto shall be brought in the courts of the Commonwealth.
